

# The Chambers

Isaiah 26:20

*"Come, my people, enter you into your chambers, and shut your doors about you: hide yourself as it were for a little moment, until the indignation be overpast."*

Praise the Mighty Yah, what an interesting part of the scripture. I would like to bring certain questions to mind why the above scripture is so powerful, and what led up to this being said to our people in the end days. In order for me to do this we will have to look at some more scriptures, so let us read.

## **Psalms 83: 1-8**

### **Psalm 83**

#### **Prayer against Enemies**

**A song. A psalm of Asaph.** <sup>(A)</sup>

<sup>1</sup> Yah, do not keep silent.

Do not be deaf, Yah; do not be idle. <sup>(B)</sup>

<sup>2</sup> See how Your enemies make an uproar;  
those who **hate You** have acted arrogantly. <sup>(C)</sup> <sup>[a]</sup>

<sup>3</sup> They devise clever schemes against Your people;  
they **conspire against** Your treasured ones. <sup>(D)</sup>

<sup>4</sup> They say, "Come, let us **wipe them out as a nation**  
so that **Israel's name** will no longer be remembered." <sup>(E)</sup>

<sup>5</sup> For they have conspired with **one mind**;  
they form an alliance <sup>[b]</sup> against You <sup>(E)</sup> —

<sup>6</sup> the tents of Edom and the Ishmaelites, <sup>(G)</sup>  
Moab and the Hagrites, <sup>(H)</sup>

<sup>7</sup> Gebal, Ammon, and Amalek, <sup>(1)</sup>  
Philistia with the inhabitants of Tyre. <sup>(2)</sup>

<sup>8</sup> Even Assyria has joined them;  
they lend support <sup>(c)</sup> to the sons of Lot. <sup>(k)</sup> <sup>(d)</sup>

This was just the beginning; according to scriptures the word tells us in other passages that it was Yah that allowed us to be placed in slavery, but it is important to note that Yah's chosen people though in slavery were not to be treated just any kind of way;

## [Isaiah 47:6](#)

"I was angry with My people; (Because of their sins)  
I profaned My possession,  
and I placed them under your control.  
You **showed them no mercy**;  
you made your yoke very heavy on the elderly."

## [Lamentations 1:3](#)

Judah is gone into captivity because of **affliction**, and because of great servitude: she dwells (Lives) among the heathen, she finds no rest: all **her persecutors** overtook her between the straits.

## [Isaiah 52:5](#)

Now therefore, what have I here, says Yah, that my people is taken away for nought? they that rule over them make them to **howl**, says YAH; and my name continually every day is blasphemed.

## [Zechariah 1:14-17](#)

<sup>14</sup> Then the angel said to me, "Shout this message for all to hear: 'This is what YAH of Heaven's Armies says: My love for Jerusalem and Mount Zion is passionate and strong. <sup>15</sup> But I am very angry with the other nations that are now enjoying peace and security. **I was only a little angry with my people**, but the nations inflicted harm on them **far beyond my intentions**."

## *Joel 3:3 (The Message)*

### Yah Is a Safe Hiding Place

<sup>1-3</sup> "In those days, yes, at that very time when I put life back together again for Judah and Jerusalem, I'll assemble all the godless nations.

I'll lead them down into Judgment Valley  
And put them all on trial, and judge them one and all  
because of their treatment of my own people Israel.  
They scattered my people all over the pagan world  
and grabbed my land for themselves.  
They threw dice for my people  
and used them for barter.  
They would trade a boy for a whore,  
sell a girl for a bottle of wine when they wanted a drink.

### Obadiah 1:13

You should not have entered into the gate of my people in the day of their calamity; yea, You should not have looked on their **affliction** in the day of their calamity, nor have laid hands on their substance in the day of their calamity;

Now if we weigh out all of the above scriptures, it becomes abundantly clear to us that we did crimes against Yah so terrible that Yah no longer protected us from the powerful armies of other nations. This led to our Nation being sent into slavery and was treated in an inhumane way; Yah left us and returned to a place in the heavens, but this treatment did not escape the mind or memory of Yah, and Yah Himself would call for an accounting of the nations that treated His people like dogs, please read;

### Hosea 5:15

<sup>15</sup>I will go and return to my place, till they acknowledge their offence, and seek my face: in their affliction they will seek me early.

**Whoever signs the Covenant** acknowledges Yah and releases the parking brake so to speak that allows Yah to return to give us aid, and Yah also returns to punish those responsible for the ill treatment of His people; Yah's return is two fold or for two reasons, to show mercy to His people and punishment to the nations please read;

<sup>12</sup> Shining morning star, <sup>(A)</sup> <sup>[a]</sup>  
how you have fallen from the heavens! <sup>(B)</sup>  
You destroyer of nations,  
you have been cut down to the ground.

<sup>13</sup> You said to yourself:  
"I will ascend to the heavens; <sup>(C)</sup>  
I will set up my throne  
above the stars of Yah. <sup>(D)</sup>  
I will sit on the mount of the [gods'] assembly,  
in the remotest parts of the North. <sup>(E)</sup> <sup>[b]</sup>

<sup>14</sup> I will ascend above the highest clouds;  
I will make myself like the Most High."

<sup>15</sup> But you will be brought down to Sheol  
into the deepest regions of the Pit. <sup>(E)</sup>

<sup>16</sup> Those who see you will stare at you;  
they will look closely at you:  
"**Is this the man** who caused the earth to tremble,  
who shook the kingdoms,

<sup>17</sup> who turned the world into a wilderness, <sup>(G)</sup>  
who trampled its cities  
and would not release the prisoners to return home?"

## *Isaiah 14:21 (New Living Translation)*

<sup>21</sup> Kill this man's children!

Let them die **because of their father's sins!**

They must not rise and conquer the earth,  
filling the world with their cities."

### Jeremiah 51:8

**Babylon** is **suddenly** fallen and destroyed: howl for her; take balm for her pain, if so be she may be healed.

### Revelation 18:10

Standing afar off for the fear of her torment, saying, Alas, alas that great city Babylon, that mighty city! for in **one hour** is thy judgment come.

### Jeremiah 15:11

YAH said, Verily **it shall be well with thy remnant**; verily I will cause the enemy to entreat thee well in **the time of evil** and in the time of **affliction**.

**Did you notice that it is during the time of evil that Yah returns to help His people?**

### Zechariah 1:16

<sup>16</sup> "Therefore, this is what YAH says: **I have returned to show mercy** to Jerusalem. My Temple will be rebuilt, says YAH of Heaven's Armies, and measurements will be taken for the reconstruction of Jerusalem.<sup>[c]</sup>

<sup>17</sup> "Say this also: 'This is what YAH of Heaven's Armies says: The towns of Israel will again overflow with prosperity, and YAH will again comfort Zion and choose Jerusalem as his own.'"

### Jeremiah 46:28

Fear you not, O Jacob my servant, says YAH: for I am with thee; for I will make a **full end** of all **the nations** where I have driven

(scattered) you: but I will not make a **full end** of you, but correct you in measure; yet will I not leave you wholly unpunished.

Don't get too settled in your mind and think that those guilty of inflicting harsh bondage or slavery on your people are the only ones who will pay for illicit (low down) behavior, the Creator Yah is Punishing the entire earth, this includes **rebellious** Israelites.

This time of punishment is not to be taken lightly for the entire inhabitants of the earth are forewarned;

## **Zechariah 2:13**

## **Psalms 33:14**

From the place of his **habitation** he looks upon all the inhabitants of the earth.

## **Psalms 68:5**

A father of the fatherless, and a judge of the widows, is Yah in his holy **habitation**.

## **Psalms 74:20**

Have **respect unto the covenant**: for the dark places of the earth are full of the **habitations** of cruelty.

A small window of opportunity is given Yah's people for them to accept the Covenant established long ago and re-instituted in our day and time. For those who wisely accept Yah's terms of surrender; which is the turning away from your sin, Yah has promised redemption.

<sup>1</sup> In that day, everyone in the land of Judah will sing this song:

Our city is strong!

We are surrounded by the walls of Yah's salvation.

<sup>2</sup> Open the gates to all who are righteous;  
allow the faithful to enter.

<sup>3</sup> You will keep in perfect peace  
all who trust in you,  
all whose thoughts are fixed on you!

<sup>4</sup> Trust in YAH always,  
for YAH EL is the eternal Rock.

<sup>5</sup> He humbles the proud  
and brings down the arrogant city.  
He brings it down to the dust.

<sup>6</sup> The poor and oppressed trample it underfoot,  
and the needy walk all over it.

<sup>7</sup> But for those who are righteous,  
the way is not steep and rough.  
You are a God who does what is right,  
and you smooth out the path ahead of them.

<sup>8</sup> Yah, we show our trust in you by obeying your laws;  
our heart's desire is to glorify your name.

<sup>9</sup> All night long I search for you;  
in the morning I earnestly seek for Yah.

**For only when you come to judge the earth**  
will people learn **what is right**.

<sup>10</sup> Your kindness to the wicked  
does not make them do good.  
Although others do right, the wicked keep doing wrong  
and take no notice of Yah's majesty.

<sup>11</sup> O Yah, they pay no attention to your upraised fist.  
Show them your eagerness to defend your people.

Then they will be ashamed.  
Let your fire consume your enemies.

<sup>12</sup> Yah, you will grant us peace;  
all we have accomplished is really from you.

<sup>13</sup> O Yah our God, others have ruled us,  
but you alone are the one we worship.

<sup>14</sup> Those we served before are dead and gone.  
Their departed spirits will never return!  
You attacked them and destroyed them,  
and they are long forgotten.

<sup>15</sup> O Yah, you have made our nation great;  
yes, you have made us great.  
You have extended our borders,  
and we give you the glory!

<sup>16</sup> Yah, in distress we searched for you.  
We prayed beneath the burden of your discipline.

<sup>17</sup> Just as a pregnant woman  
writhes and cries out in pain as she gives birth,  
so were we in your presence, Yah. (Isaiah 66:7-8)

<sup>18</sup> We, too, writhe in agony,  
but nothing comes of our suffering.  
We have not given salvation to the earth,  
nor brought life into the world.

<sup>19</sup> But those who die in YAH will live;  
their bodies will rise again!  
Those who sleep in the earth  
will rise up and sing for joy!  
For your life-giving light will fall like dew  
on your people in the place of the dead!

## Restoration for Israel

<sup>20</sup> Go home, my people,  
and lock your doors!  
Hide yourselves for a little while  
until Yah's anger has passed.

<sup>21</sup> Look! YAH is coming from heaven  
to punish the people of the earth for their sins.  
The earth will no longer hide those who have been killed.  
They will be brought out for all to see.

Now that a lot has been shown to us in scriptures, what or where is this chamber that we are to retreat to for our National safety; and what about the people who are looked in prisons and given life sentences by the governments of the world, but they have completely turned to Yah and received a pardon by Yah?

It would seem that the prison systems of this world with their corporate money making bond system would not voluntarily give up such a money making cash cow; so what about these Hebrew Israelite brothers and sisters? What does the word of Yah have to say about their release, also one should keep in mind that this release IS FOR THOSE who return back to Yah.

Scripture tells us that those who change for a mere moment and hope to fool or hide their true unrighteous character are considered rebels and will not see the homeland; Israel.

## Isaiah 42

- <sup>1</sup> "Look at my servant, whom I strengthen.  
He is my chosen one, who pleases me.  
I have put my Spirit upon him.  
He will bring justice to the nations.
- <sup>2</sup> He will not shout  
or raise his voice in public.
- <sup>3</sup> He will not crush the weakest reed  
or put out a flickering candle.  
He will bring justice to all who have been wronged.
- <sup>4</sup> He will not falter or lose heart  
until justice prevails throughout the earth.  
Even distant lands beyond the sea will wait for his instruction.<sup>[a]</sup>"
- <sup>5</sup> Yah, created the heavens and stretched them out.  
He created the earth and everything in it.

He gives breath to everyone,  
life to everyone who walks the earth.

And it is he who says,

<sup>6</sup> "I, Yah, have called you to demonstrate my righteousness.

I will take you by the hand and guard you,

and I will give you to my people, Israel,  
as a symbol of my covenant with them.

And you will be a light to guide the nations.

<sup>7</sup> You will open the eyes of the blind.

You will free the captives from prison,  
releasing those who sit in dark dungeons.

<sup>8</sup> "I am Yah; that is my name!

I will not give my glory to anyone else,  
nor share my praise with carved idols.

<sup>9</sup> Everything I prophesied has come true,  
and now I will prophesy again.

I will tell you the future before it happens."

## Psalm 79:11

Let the sighing of the prisoner come before thee; according to the greatness of thy power preserve thou those that are **appointed to die**;

## Psalm 102:19-22 (King James Version)

<sup>19</sup>For he hath looked down from the height of his sanctuary; from heaven did Yah behold the earth;

<sup>20</sup>To hear the groaning of the prisoner; to loose those that are appointed to death;

<sup>21</sup>To declare the name of Yah in Zion, and his praise in Jerusalem;

## Isaiah 48:3-11

<sup>3</sup> Long ago I told you what was going to happen.

Then suddenly I took action,  
and all my predictions came true.

<sup>4</sup> For I know how stubborn and obstinate you are.

Your necks are as unbending as iron.  
Your heads are as hard as bronze.

<sup>5</sup> That is why I told you what would happen;

I told you beforehand what I was going to do.

- Then you could never say, 'My idols did it.  
My wooden image and metal god commanded it to happen!'
- <sup>6</sup> You have heard my predictions and seen them fulfilled,  
but you refuse to admit it.  
Now I will tell you new things,  
secrets you have not yet heard.
- <sup>7</sup> They are brand new, not things from the past.  
So you cannot say, 'We knew that all the time!'
- <sup>8</sup> "Yes, I will tell you of things that are entirely new,  
things you never heard of before.  
For I know so well what traitors you are.  
You have been rebels from birth.
- <sup>9</sup> Yet for my own sake and for the honor of my name,  
I will hold back my anger and not wipe you out.
- <sup>10</sup> I have refined you, but not as silver is refined.  
Rather, I have refined you in the furnace of suffering.
- <sup>11</sup> I will rescue you for my sake—  
yes, for my own sake!  
I will not let my reputation be tarnished,  
and I will not share my glory with idols!

The Babylon system of evil has received its final warning before we were born, but new revelations are reserved for our day and time to drive the point home in our minds that Yah is Supreme, this must be done like this because of the advancement of man's technology and devices of deception, but it won't help them, please read;

## Isaiah 47

### Prediction of Babylon's Fall

- <sup>1</sup> "Come down, virgin daughter of Babylon, and sit in the dust.  
For your days of sitting on a throne have ended.  
O daughter of Babylonia,<sup>[a]</sup> never again will you be  
the lovely princess, tender and delicate.
- <sup>2</sup> Take heavy millstones and grind flour.  
Remove your veil, and strip off your robe.  
Expose yourself to public view.
- <sup>3</sup> You will be naked and burdened with shame.  
I will take vengeance against you without pity."

- <sup>4</sup> Our Redeemer, whose name is Yah of Heaven's Armies,  
is the Holy One of Israel.
- <sup>5</sup> "O beautiful Babylon, sit now in darkness and silence.  
Never again will you be known as the queen of kingdoms.
- <sup>6</sup> For I was angry with my chosen people  
and punished them by letting them fall into your hands.  
But you, Babylon, showed them no mercy.  
You oppressed even the elderly.
- <sup>7</sup> You said, 'I will reign forever as **queen of the world!**'  
You did not reflect on your actions  
or think about their consequences.
- <sup>8</sup> "Listen to this, you pleasure-loving kingdom,  
living at ease and feeling secure.  
You say, 'I am the only one, and there is no other.  
I will never be a widow or lose my children.'
- <sup>9</sup> Well, both these things will **come upon you in a moment:**  
widowhood and the loss of your children.  
Yes, these calamities will come upon you,  
despite all your witchcraft and magic.
- <sup>10</sup> "You felt secure in your wickedness.  
'No one sees me,' you said.  
But your 'wisdom' and 'knowledge' have led you astray,  
and you said, 'I am the only one, and there is no other.'
- <sup>11</sup> So disaster will overtake you,  
and you won't be able to charm it away.  
Calamity will fall upon you,  
and you won't be able to buy your way out.  
A catastrophe will strike you suddenly,  
one for which you are not prepared.
- <sup>12</sup> "Now use your magical charms!  
Use the spells you have worked at all these years!  
Maybe they will do you some good.  
Maybe they can make someone afraid of you.
- <sup>13</sup> All the advice you receive has made you tired.  
Where are all your astrologers,  
those stargazers who make predictions each month?  
Let them stand up and save you from what the future holds.
- <sup>14</sup> But they are like straw burning in a fire;

they cannot save themselves from the flame.  
You will get no help from them at all;  
their hearth is no place to sit for warmth.  
<sup>15</sup> And all your friends,  
those with whom you've done business since childhood,  
will go their own ways,  
turning a deaf ear to your cries.

You break the teeth of the wicked. <sup>(K)</sup>

<sup>8</sup> Salvation belongs to YAH; <sup>(L)</sup>  
may Your blessing be on Your people. <sup>(M)</sup>
