

RULES FOR THE KINGDOM OF YAH OF HOSTS FLAG

Our Flag contains the Holy Name of Almighty YAH and must be revered and shown respect at ALL times.

- 1) The flag should never touch anything beneath it, such as the ground, the floor, water, or merchandise.
- 2) Flag is to be displayed from a staff projecting the flag horizontally or at an angle from the window sill, balcony, or front of a building.
- 3) When flag is displayed on a wall, it must be laid horizontally and positioned correctly so that the Name of YAH is read from right to left. (Grommets should be on the left).
- 4) Whenever possible, the flag should not be displayed on days when the weather is inclement – high winds, snow or thundershowers.
- 5) The flag should never be fastened, displayed, used, or stored in such a manner as to permit it to be easily torn, soiled, or damaged in any way.
- 6) Flag is to be cleaned when it becomes soiled.
- 7) Flag material is Nylon, and if flag becomes dirty looking, it may be **washed in a clothes washer set on a gentle cycle, using cold water and a mild detergent**. Nylon flags **may be tumble dried** in a clothes dryer **using a low heat setting**.
- 8) The flag should never be used as wearing apparel, bedding, or drapery. No part of the flag should ever be used as a costume or athletic uniform.
- 9) The flag should never have placed upon it, nor on any part of it, nor attached to it any mark, insignia, letter, word, figure, design, picture, or drawing of any nature.
- 10) The flag should not be draped over the hood, top, sides, or back of a vehicle or of a motorcycle, moped, bicycle, wagon or a boat.
- 11) The flag should never be used as a receptacle for receiving, holding, carrying, or delivering anything.
- 12) The flag should never be used for advertising purposes by any person or group, only used in the mission purpose of The Kingdom of YAH of HOSTS. Advertising signs should not be fastened to a staff or halyard from which the flag is flown.

NOTE: When the flag is in such condition that it is no longer fitting for display, it will be disposed of in an honorable and dignified way. Please contact the National Treasurer, AviEla YisraEl, to dispose of your flag. A **prepaid** envelope will be sent to you to mail

back to the Treasurer. Postage will be paid by the Treasurer for The Kingdom of YAH of Hosts. HALLELUYAH!
