


## Blood Moon



### Joel 2:31

**The sun will become dark**, and the **moon will turn blood red** before that great and terrible day of Yah arrives.

### Malachi 4:5

"Look, I am **sending** you the prophet **Elijah** before the great and dreadful day of Yah arrives.

### Malachi 4:5

" Behold I will send you Elijah the prophet **before the coming** of the great and dreadful day of YAH."

What an interesting scripture. If you look closely at the words above, especially at the **name** of who is going to be sent in the end time, you just might learn something for the first time; something that has been overlooked that has been right before your eyes. His name is Elijah - Eli**Yah**.

Let's look at the meaning of this name and see if we may discover a deeper meaning that is hidden. Looking in the Strong's Exhaustive Concordance of The Bible in the Hebrew dictionary we find his name located on page 8 under numbers 452, 410, 3045 Elijah - (ee lie juh) the main meaning is God Of Yah, strength, almighty.

Is this description of the son of man called Elijah wrong in translation by saying God of YAH? If we examine yet another name found in Daniel the 12th chapter and the first verse we find the name of The Great Prince Michael whose name means "who is like YAH?" found in the concordance at 4317. If we are to simply understand what these two significant meanings are and how do we properly apply them, we would come a few steps closer to "The Secrets" locked in the scriptures. When the definition says God of Yah, it means one who is from Yah. I believe this definition to mean SON OF YAH. So if we understand this meaning hidden in the name of Elijah and would read the verse in this manner it would read as follows;

"Behold I will send you the Son Of YAH the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of YAH." Other words, "Behold I will send you one who is the Son of Yah, before the great and dreadful day of YAH." You might ask me to prove this line of thinking I would simply say to remember the definition "God of Yah" **he is Of Yah or from Yah not over YAH.**

Now look in Isaiah 9:6 it reads;

" For unto us a child is born, unto us **a son is given**, and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor, The Mighty **God**, The Everlasting Father, The **Prince** of Peace." Looking closer you will find at least two of the seven attributes of YAHWEH that is spoken of in Isaiah 11:1-5 in the above scripture. Can you spot them? Turn to Revelation 12:5;

"And she brought forth a man child, (**a son**) who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron, and her child was caught up unto Yah, and to his throne."

If we want more food for thought turn to 2 Samuel 7:12-14 where the Most High is telling King David this; " When **your days are fulfilled** and you rest with your fathers, (David dies) I will set up your seed (**son**) after you, who will come from your body, and I will establish his kingdom. He shall build a house for my name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever. "I **will be his father, and he shall be my son**. If he commits iniquity, I will chasten him with the rod of men and with the blows of the sons of men.

## "Psalms 2:7

"I will declare the decree: Yahweh has said unto me, **You are my Son; this day have I begotten thee**. Indeed a time for secrets to be revealed. Halleluyah -Yah.

## Ezekiel 2

### Ezekiel's Call to Be a Prophet

<sup>1</sup> He said to me, "Son of man,<sup>[a]</sup> stand up on your feet and I will speak to you." <sup>2</sup> As he spoke, the Spirit came into me and raised me to my feet, and I heard him speaking to me.

<sup>3</sup> He said: "Son of man, **I am sending you to the Israelites**, to a rebellious nation that has rebelled against me; they and their ancestors have been in revolt against me to this very day. <sup>4</sup> The people to whom I am sending you are obstinate and stubborn. Say to them, 'This is what the Sovereign Yah says.' <sup>5</sup> And whether they listen or fail to listen—for they are a rebellious people—**they will know that a prophet has been among them**. <sup>6</sup> And you, son of man, do not be afraid of them or their words. Do not be afraid, though briars and thorns are all around you and you live among scorpions. Do not be afraid of what they say or be terrified by them, though they are a rebellious people. <sup>7</sup> **You must speak my words to them, whether they listen or fail to listen**, for they are rebellious. <sup>8</sup> But you, son of man, listen to what I say to you. Do not rebel like that rebellious people; open your mouth and eat what I give you."

<sup>9</sup> Then I looked, and I saw a hand stretched out to me. In it was a scroll, <sup>10</sup> which he unrolled before me. **On both sides of it were written words of lament and mourning and woe.**

### Ezekiel 3

<sup>1</sup> The voice said to me, "Son of man, eat what I am giving you—eat this scroll! Then go and give its message to the people of Israel." <sup>2</sup> So I opened my mouth, and he fed me the scroll. <sup>3</sup> "Fill your stomach with this," he said. And when I ate it, it tasted as sweet as honey in my mouth.

<sup>4</sup> Then he said, "Son of man, go to the people of Israel and give them my messages. <sup>5</sup> I am not sending you to a foreign people whose language you cannot understand. <sup>6</sup> No, I am not sending you to people with strange and difficult speech. If I did, they would listen! <sup>7</sup> But the people of Israel won't listen to you any more than they listen to me! For the whole lot of them are hard-hearted and stubborn. <sup>8</sup> **But look, I have made you as obstinate and hard-hearted as they are.** <sup>9</sup> **I have made your forehead as hard as the hardest rock! So don't be afraid of them or fear their angry looks, even though they are rebels."**

<sup>10</sup> Then he added, "Son of man, **let all my words sink deep into your own heart first.** **Listen to them carefully for yourself.** <sup>11</sup> Then go to your people in exile and say to them, 'This is what the Sovereign Yah says!' Do this whether they listen to you or not."

<sup>12</sup> Then the Spirit lifted me up, and I heard a loud rumbling sound behind me. (May the glory of Yah be praised in his place!)[a] <sup>13</sup> It was the sound of the wings of the living beings as they brushed against each other and the rumbling of their wheels beneath them.

<sup>14</sup> The Spirit lifted me up and took me away. I went in bitterness and turmoil, but Yah's hold on me was strong. <sup>15</sup> Then I came to the colony of Judean exiles in Tel-abib, beside the Kebar River. I was overwhelmed and sat among them for seven days.

#### A Watchman for Israel

<sup>16</sup> **After seven days** Yah gave me a message. He said, <sup>17</sup> "Son of man, **I have appointed you as a watchman for Israel.** **Whenever you receive a message from me, warn people immediately.** <sup>18</sup> If I warn the wicked, saying, 'You are under the penalty of death,' but you fail to deliver the warning, they will die in their sins. And I will hold you responsible for their deaths.

<sup>19</sup> If you warn them and they refuse to repent and keep on sinning, they will die in their sins. But you will have saved yourself because you obeyed me.

<sup>20</sup> "If righteous people turn away from their righteous behavior and ignore the obstacles I put in their way, they will die. And if you do not warn them, they will die in their sins. None of their righteous acts will be remembered, and I will hold you responsible for their deaths. <sup>21</sup> But if you warn righteous people not to sin and they listen to you and do not sin, they will live, and you will have saved yourself, too."

<sup>22</sup> Then Yah took hold of me and said, "Get up and go out into the valley, and I will speak to you there." <sup>23</sup> So I got up and went, and there I saw the glory of Yah, just as I had seen in my first vision by the Kebar River. And I fell face down on the ground.

<sup>24</sup> Then the Spirit came into me and set me on my feet. He spoke to me and said, "Go to your house and shut yourself in. <sup>25</sup> **There, son of man, you will be tied with ropes so you cannot go out among the people.** <sup>26</sup> And **I will make your tongue stick to the roof of your mouth so that you will be speechless and unable to rebuke them, for they are rebels.** <sup>27</sup>

**But when I give you a message**, I will loosen your tongue and let you speak. Then you will say to them, 'This is what the Sovereign Yah says!' Those who choose to listen will listen, but those who refuse will refuse, for they are rebels.

### The Year of Jubilee

<sup>8</sup> "In addition, you must count off seven Sabbath years, seven sets of seven years, **adding up to forty-nine years** in all. <sup>9</sup> **Then on the Day of Atonement** in the **fiftieth year**,<sup>[a]</sup> blow the ram's horn loud and long throughout the land. <sup>10</sup> Set this year apart as holy, a time to proclaim freedom throughout the land for all who live there. It will be a jubilee year for you, when each of you may return to the land that belonged to your ancestors and return to your own clan.

**7 days** (Ezekiel 4:6) = **7 times or years** – also used for testing the soul under affliction to see if the man or woman will turn their back on Yah. Since this one will carry the Word of Yah to Yah's people, this man must be tested according to the precept that Yah's word is purified 7 times.

### Psalm 12:6

The **words** of Yah are pure **words**: as silver tried in a furnace of earth, **purified seven times**.

Eighth Day Circumcision of the mind or receiving the spirit of the Creator Isaiah 11:1-5

### Isaiah 11

#### The Branch From Jesse

- <sup>1</sup> A shoot will come up from the stump of Jesse;  
from his roots a Branch will bear fruit.
- <sup>2</sup> The Spirit of Yah will rest on him—  
the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding,  
the Spirit of counsel and of might,  
the Spirit of the knowledge and fear of Yah—
- <sup>3</sup> and he will delight in the fear of Yah.

He will not judge by what he sees with his eyes,  
or decide by what he hears with his ears;

<sup>4</sup> but with righteousness he will judge the needy,  
with justice he will give decisions for the poor of the earth.  
He will strike the earth with the rod of his mouth;  
with the breath of his lips he will slay the wicked.

<sup>5</sup> Righteousness will be his belt  
and faithfulness the sash around his waist.

## Isaiah 59:15-20

<sup>15</sup>Yea, truth fails; and he that departs from evil makes himself a prey: and Yah saw it, and it displeased him that there was no judgment.

<sup>16</sup>And he saw that there was no man, and wondered that there was no intercessor: therefore his arm brought salvation unto him; and his righteousness, it sustained him.

<sup>17</sup>For he put on righteousness as a breastplate, and an helmet of salvation upon his head; and he put on the garments of vengeance for clothing, and was clad with zeal as a cloak.

<sup>18</sup>According to their deeds, accordingly he will repay, fury to his adversaries, recompence to his enemies; to the islands he will repay recompence.

<sup>19</sup>So shall they fear the name of Yah from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of Yah shall lift up a standard against him.

<sup>20</sup>And the Redeemer shall come to Zion, and unto them that turn from transgression in Jacob, says Yah.

### Leviticus 12:3

**And in the eighth day the flesh of his foreskin shall be circumcised.**

### Leviticus 22:27

When a bullock, or a sheep, or a goat, is brought forth, then it shall be seven **days** under the dam; and from the **eighth day** and (forward) thenceforth it shall be accepted for an offering made by fire unto Yah.

The **hot coal, - or fire** of Isaiah 6<sup>th</sup> Chapter, **done by Seraph Angel** because **no one on earth is worthy** or a clean priest.

### Leviticus 23:36

Seven **days** ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto Yah: on the **eighth day** shall be an holy convocation unto you; and ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto Yah: it is a solemn assembly; and ye shall do no servile work therein.
